Following are some skills, which will be useful for your child in entering Kindergarten:

- Is learning to follow directions
- Recognizes some letters (upper and lower case) and numbers
- Is learning to work well with other children
- Sits and listens to a complete short story
- Shows willingness to try new things

What can families do to help a child be ready for Kindergarten?

- Give lots of opportunities to use pencils, crayons, scissors and play dough (not directed activities-just experience)
- Help their child count and sort objects
- READ to their child daily
- Provide playtime with other children of the same age
- Talk to their child; listen to their child
- Limit the amount of time your child spends in front of the T.V. or computer, it can be harmful to eye, brain, large and small muscle development, as well as social/emotional development.
